Welcome Dr. Ken Pruitt

This morning we welcome to our pulpit Dr. Ken Pruitt, President of the John Leland Center for Theological Studies. Leland is the Baptist seminary in Arlington which our pastor, Dr. Mark Olson, served as President from 2007 until he accepted the call to come to Haymarket Baptist Church in 2017.

Dr. Pruitt is well prepared academically for his leadership of Leland Seminary. He earned an M.Div. at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, did additional study in the area of Marriage and Family Counseling, and then completed a Doctor of Ministry (D.Min.) at Baylor University's Truett Seminary in Waco, TX.

Before coming to Leland, he served in full-time Christian ministry for more than 30 years in Texas, North and South Carolina, and most recently at King's Grant Baptist Church in Virginia Beach, VA.

Dr. Pruitt has also ministered extensively in India, where he regularly serves as a keynote speaker in conferences and graduations of the Nagpur Theological Seminary. He is married to his high school sweetheart Terry, and they have three beautiful daughters, Nichole (25), Bethany (23), and Sarah Joy (11). Each daughter is adopted, and each adoption expresses a unique story of God's grace and love for a broken and hurting world.
