DISASTER RESPONSE: REBUILDING WITH HOPE

After Hurricane Helene devastated Taylor's Valley, Carl and Linda's home was destroyed. Separated during the storm, they were miraculously reunited. Soon after, Impact Disaster Response volunteers arrived, bringing hope, comfort, and practical help. They stayed, listened, prayed, and worked alongside survivors with compassion and determination.
