
Welcome Dr. Jim Weaver

This morning we welcome to our pulpit Dr. Jim Weaver. Jim Weaver retired in March, 2016, after serving more than twenty years as the pastor of First Baptist Church of Springfield, Virginia. In addition to his ministry in Springfield, Jim has been the pastor of churches in Indiana, North Carolina, and Kentucky, and he has served on the staff of churches in Virginia and Kentucky. He has also been an adjunct professor at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky, Montreat-Anderson College in North Carolina, and the John Leland Center for Theological Studies in Northern Virginia.

Jim, the son of a Baptist pastor in Virginia, was born in Lynchburg. He attended public schools in Prince William County and the City of Richmond. He is a graduate of Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. He earned the Master of Divinity degree and the Doctor of Philosophy degree in New Testament from the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Jim and his wife, Diane, have two daughters and a son and six granddaughters and two grandsons.
