Deacon Nomination Process

Each year our congregation starts the process to nominate deacons to serve our church. Deacons serve three-year terms and then are replaced by a new class of deacons who are nominated by our congregation.

This year we will nominate four new deacons to replace those who are rotating off the deacon board, and so we ask each member to nominate four church members to serve as deacons. Our constitution lists the following qualifications for deacons, "Nominees must be Christ-centered mature growing Christians, and members who are contributing to the life and mission of the church." The Biblical guidelines for selecting deacons are outlined by Paul in 1 Timothy 3:8-13:

"In the same way, deacons are to be worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain. They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. They must first be tested, and then if there is nothing against them, let them serve as deacons."

"In the same way, the women are to be worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything."

"A deacon must be faithful to his wife and must manage his children and his household well. Those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus."
